1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Mewies Engineering Consultants Ltd (M-EC) has been commissioned by Clowes Developments Ltd and East Staffordshire Borough Council to undertake a Travel Plan (TP) for a proposed mixed use residential and commercial development on land off The Dove Way, Uttoxeter. A site location plan and proposed site layout are provided in Appendix A.

- 1.2 This document has been produced in order to help reduce the dependency on private car travel from the site and promote sustainable travel techniques using guidance from the Department for Transport document entitled 'Good Practice Guidelines: Delivering Travel Plans through the Planning Process'.
- 1.3 In order to assist in the production of this report reference has been made to the Staffordshire County Council (SCC) Guidelines for Transport Assessments and Travel Plans (January 2008).
- 1.4 This Travel Plan document will focus on the sustainable measures to be implemented by the proposed development and details a package of measures designed to reduce the number of car borne journeys. This document will also set out the key objectives of the Travel Plan which includes a modal shift target.
- 1.5 M-EC has completed this report for the benefit of the organisations/individuals referred to in paragraph 1.1 and any relevant statutory authority which may require reference in relation to approvals for the proposed development. 3.0 SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES

In recent years there has been a fundamental shift in transport policy towards encouraging use of more sustainable modes of travel and reducing use of the car particularly when only one person is in the car. This policy is at the heart of recent Government guidance in the form the 2004 transport White Paper "The Future of Transport" Chapter 3, and Local Transport Plans. The "Smarter Choices – Changing the Way We Travel" initiative published in 2006 looks at the factors associated with sustainable travel, this includes workplace travel plans, personalised travel planning, public transport awareness, and information, car sharing schemes, teleworking and teleconferencing, these areas have been covered where appropriate in this Travel Plan.

- 3.2 Travel Plans are also an important tool in the reduction of social exclusion. If new developments are only accessible by car, people without a car will not be in a position to apply for jobs there. This is not only a social inclusion issue for the area but could also be a recruitment issue for the employer.
- 3.3 The principles of sustainable transport and movement have been developed further in Communities and Local Government document; Planning Policy Statement 3 (PPS3): June 2010 as highlighted below:

PPS3 Paragraph 16:

Matters to consider when assessing design quality include the extent to which the development;

- Is easily accessible and well connected to public transport and community facilities and services, and is well laid out so all the space is used efficiently is safe, accessible and user friendly.
- Takes a design lead approach to the provision of car parking space that is well integrated with a high quality public realm and streets that are pedestrian, cycle and vehicle friendly.

DfT Circular 02/2007 Paragraph 33:

Demand management covers the range of techniques used to reduce traffic generation. Having regard to the guidance set out in PPG13, paragraph 89, developers, working in partnership with local authorities (where appropriate), must submit plans for the implementation and maintenance of measures that will minimise the traffic generated by their development. This is likely to be through travel plans. These will include, but will not be limited to, measures to manage car use, particularly by single occupants. Examples of such techniques may include tailored provision of public transport, car sharing/pooling, parking control, and the encouragement of cycling and walking.

- 3.4 The key aims and objectives of this Travel Plan are to reduce dependency on the car by encouraging increased use of walking, cycling and public transport. Specifically the plan will seek to:
 - Reduce the impact of the development on the local highway network.
 - Improve accessibility to key local amenities and facilities.
 - Increase awareness to new occupants of the site to the alternatives of car travel by promoting increased travel awareness.
 - To provide and promote pedestrian, cycling and public transport journeys from the site.
 - To provide safe walking and cycling facilities in and around the site.
 - To design a development layout that provides appropriate routes for all modes of travel.
- 3.5 This Travel Plan document will seek to outline how the proposed aims and objectives will be achieved to ensure a lasting modal shift.
- 3.6 SCC and the HA have been contacted in order to scope the requirements of this Travel Plan and all relevant correspondence is provided in Appendix C.

4.0 SITE DESCRIPTION

- 4.1 The site is located on both the eastern and western boundaries of The Dove Way and is approximately 1km to the north of Uttoxeter and 18km to the north west of Burton upon Trent. The closest amenities to the site are located within Uttoxeter with a Post Office, supermarkets, a library, several banks and other convenience stores.
- 4.2 The residential site is bound by a sports field and open field to the north, The Dove Way to the east and further sports fields and an area of residential housing to the south. The western boundary of the site comprises of a public refuse tip and scrubland backing on to the premises of a building contractors. The site currently comprises of open scrubland and scattered groups of trees.
- 4.3 The commercial element of the site is bound to the north by the A50, The Dove Way to the west, and a sewerage works and open fields to the south and east. The site currently comprises of a mixture of open fields, hedgerows and unmaintained scrubland.

5.0 SUSTAINABILITY

Existing Public Transport Facilities

Bus

There are a number of existing bus services operating in Uttoxeter. The 1A and 1E services operate along between Uttoxeter and Burton via Tutbury from Uttoxeter Bus Station to the south of the site at regular intervals while service number 409 provides links between Uttoxeter and Ashbourne. Service number 4 links much of the residential area of Uttoxeter with the Tesco superstore located on Town Meadows Way with service number 32 providing links with Cheadle and Hanley. Bus timetable information is provided in Appendix B and Table 1 below provides a summary of the public transport services operating within Uttoxeter.

The closest bus stops to the residential site are located on Cheadle Road/High Street approximately 500 metres walking distance south west of the proposed development. These are flag stops only with no timetable information, shelter provision or raised kerbs. For the commercial site, the bus stops on Cheadle Road/High Street are located approximately 750 metres walking distance from the site boundary. Drawing 20111_15_002 in Appendix B shows the existing bus stop locations and bus routes as detailed above.

Rail

5.3 The nearest train station to the site is situated within Uttoxeter; approximately 1.1km to the south of the site. This station provides a link to major towns and cities including Stoke on Trent, Derby and Crewe and includes secure cycle storage. Table 2 below provides details on rail services to the major destinations.


Existing Pedestrian Facilities

- According to the National Travel Survey (Goodman et al, 1998), walking constitutes 29% of all journeys made in a year, on a national scale. Planning Policy Guidance 13 (PPG13) Transport, states that walking is the most important mode of travel at the local level and offers the greatest potential to replace short car trips, particularly under 2km. The Department of Transport National Statistics, Personal Travel Fact Sheet No.4 January 2003 entitled "Walking in Great Britain" states that 4 out of 5 (77%) of walking trips were under a mile (1.6km) and only 8% were 2 miles or above in length.
- Drawing 20111_15_003 in Appendix B identifies the location of key amenities and facilities located within 2km of the site and walking routes from the site to these facilities. Amenities within Uttoxeter are located approximately 600 metres walking distance south of the residential site and can be accessed from a pedestrian link from the site onto Pennycroft Lane and existing footways along Park Street and High Street. For the commercial development, amenities are situated approximately 900 metres walking distance from the site and are accessed via footways along The Dove Way and Town Meadows Way (Tesco) or The Dove Way and Dove Bank (Uttoxeter town centre).
- 5.6 St Mary's First School is situated 0.5km west of the site on Heath Road which can be accessed via Park Street, Cheadle Road and Heath Road. Thomas Alleynes High School is located 0.3km south of the proposed development on Dove Bank which is accessible from Park Street, High Street, Bradley Street, Back Lane and Dove Bank.
- 5.7 The nearest large supermarket from the commercial site is Tesco which is situated approximately 1km to the south of the site in Uttoxeter and can be accessed via The Dove Way and Town Meadows Way. The closest local supermarket is Tesco Express, situated

0.75km from the site boundary on Holly Road and can be accessed via Park Street, Cheadle Road and Holly Road.

Existing Cycling Facilities

- 5.8 PPG13 states that cycling has the potential to substitute short car trips, particularly those less than 5 km. The DoT National Statistics, Person Travel Fact Sheet 5A January 2003 entitled "Cycling in Great Britain," states that the average length of a cycle stage was 2.4 miles (3.86km) and that 10% of cycle trips were 5 miles (8km) or over in length.
- 5.9 A review of the Sustrans website has determined that there is a traffic free cycle route on The Dove Way and heading west along Old Knotty Way. In Addition, a cycle route is identified east along the A50 forming national route 54 leading to national route 549 on Derby Road heading east to Sudbury, Scropton and Hatton.



5.10 Drawing 20111_15_004 in Appendix B shows the existing cycle facilities located within the local area and also highlights the facilities and amenities located within 5km of the site.

6.0 THE TRAVEL PLAN TARGET

6.1 Census dataset UV37 (2001) shows that single car occupancy trips for travel to work in the East Staffordshire area is 69%. The Census data shows that there are 51,101 people aged 16-74 in employment (economically active) with 4,629 of these people currently working from home. Table 3 below provides a summary of the Travel to Work statistics for the East Staffordshire area taken from the 2001 census.

- 6.2 The census data detailed above shows 69% of the current population travel to work by single occupancy car vehicles.
- 6.3 The target for both the residential and commercial developments will be to reduce the number of single car occupancy trips to and from the site by 10%. This will be achieved through the promotion of car sharing to increase the number of car passengers, an increase in public transport patronage and an increase in walking and cycling. The Travel Plan target will be achieved through the implementation of the package of measures detailed in Section 7.0 of this report.
- Detailed below are the expected approximate modal shift targets for the development should a 10% reduction in single occupancy car journeys be achieved (note 10% of 69% = 6.9%).

The target detailed above will be achieved through a series of SMART (specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, time bound) targets and following the implementation of the package of measures outlined in Section 7.0 of this Travel Plan. The Travel Plan Coordinator will be responsible for determining any interim targets in order to assist with achieving the overall target and outlining any further targets should the initial target be achieved within the 5 year period.

7.0 **PACKAGE OF MEASURES**

7.1 This section will list and provide information on the measures to be implemented as part of both the residential and commercial development in order to meet the key aims and objectives highlighted previously and the modal shift target detailed in Section 6.0. This section will seek to confirm the proposals to be implemented and at what stage in the development.

Welcome Packs

- Welcome packs will be provided to all new dwellings from 1st occupation. The packs will be 7.2 updated every 12 months and reissued to existing and new residents and units within the commercial development up to the completion of the development. The packs will provide the following formation:
 - Plans of safe pedestrian routes to all local amenities such as schools, shops, employment, leisure facilities and health facilities.
 - Bus timetable information and routes maps of services operational along Park Street and Dove Bank.
 - Train timetable information for the most popular local routes as well as national services operational from Uttoxeter station in conjunction with information on secure bicycle parking at Uttoxeter station.
 - Information about the Travel Plan including how it works, why it is required and the purpose of the travel plan.
 - Details of the role and purpose of the Travel Plan Co-ordinator also including contact details.
 - Provide details of car share websites such as liftshare.com operating in area to encourage residents to car share.
 - Details of how to apply for temporary 1 x 3 month free bus pass.

Travel Passes

7.3 As part of the welcome packs it is proposed to provide an application form per dwelling, so that each household has the opportunity to apply for one free travel passes that will entitle applicants to temporary free travel on local bus. The travel pass will be provided for a temporary time period and it will be the resident's responsibility to complete the application

form in the welcome packs. Once the form is completed they can submit this to the on-site sales team or the Travel Plan coordinator.

7.4 Bus use (facilitated by the provision of bus route plans, timetables and the provision of temporary free bus passes) and increased cycle use are directly linked to a reduction in car bourne trips and this will be supported by the provision of further information to educate residents of sustainable travel methods and the health and environmental benefits this brings.

Staff training

7.5 Members of the sales team will be educated on the principles of sustainable travel prior to 1st occupation to ensure that residents and future users of the site are made fully aware of alternative travel means to and from the site area. Sales staff will be encouraged to promote travel arrangements and sustainable access options to residents making enquiries on properties. Copies of Public Transport information, walking and cycling maps and information on the purpose and role of the site Travel Plan Co-ordinator will be kept in the sales office and distributed to potential purchasers who visit the sales office along with the usual sales and marketing information.

Promotion of Car Share Websites/Databases

7.6 Details of national car share databases will be promoted to all residents via the Welcome Packs and Travel Plan Coordinator. Residents and users of the site will be encouraged to register with websites such as www.liftshare.com and Staffordshire's Share a Lift (www.share-a-lift.co.uk) which enable residents and employees to register their journey details on a national database. Their journey details are then checked against the database of other local residents/employees signed up to the car share scheme and a trip-matching exercise is undertaken. The Travel Plan Coordinator will assist residents in trying to establish trip matches.

Public Transport Improvements

7.7 It is proposed that bus stops are provided along The Dove Way thus ensuring public transport facilities are easily reachable on foot from both the residential and commercial developments.

These stops should feature full timetable information along with raised kerbs and a shelter facility.

Walking Bus Scheme

7.8 A walking bus scheme will be considered and discussed with the future residents of the residential site at the stage of first occupation. The aim of the walking bus is to facilitate the safe movement of school children to/from school whilst supervised by parents or suitable appointed personnel. The Travel Plan Coordinator will be responsible for looking into the feasibility of this proposal and making the relevant arrangements.

Pedestrian Improvements

- 7.9 A pedestrian link from the proposed commercial development through to the existing residential development on the opposite side of The Dove Way will be provided utilising the existing walkway under the carriageway. This pedestrian link will also extend north to the existing footway/cycleway along the A50. The residential development will also allow a connection to made onto the existing walkway on The Dove Way along with a link extending west from the residential development onto Pennycroft Lane/Park Street to facilitate access south west towards the town centre, bus stops, the Tesco Express located on Holly Road and other facilities and amenities located in this area.
- 7.10 Pedestrian refuges will be provided as part of the construction of the access roundabout with dropped kerbs and tactile paving facilitating movement across The Dove Way.

8.0 THE TRAVEL PLAN COORDINATOR ROLE

8.1 The Travel Plan Coordinator will act as the promoter of the components of the Travel plan and will be a key contact point for residents, staff and other people who will use the site. For the 2 respective sites the ravel Plan Coordinator will be as follows:

Residential: An internal member of Clowes Developments Ltd Commercial: The respective land owner (site is being sold on)

- 8.2 The main responsibilities of the Travel Plan Coordinator will be to:
 - Ensure delivery of the travel incentives once the Travel Plan is approved.
 - Promoting the individual measures of the Travel Plan.
 - Ensuring the approved Travel Plan and its component parts are being actioned.
 - Liaison with SCC who will monitor the Travel Plan implementation.
 - Production of the annual report and travel questionnaires.
 - Provide bespoke and personalised travel planning to residents and staff.
 - Provide support to each commercial units individual travel needs via the appointed members.
- 8.3 The Travel Plan coordinators role will be active for the entire build period of the development in order to provide ongoing advice and assistance to users of the site. The responsibility of residential aspect of the plan and its continued management will then fall to the residents steering group which will be established by the end of the development. This group will be suitably briefed and competent in order to continue the Travel Plan and ensure modal shift for the residential development is maintained.
- 8.4 Responsibility for the commercial aspect of the Travel Plan will fall to the appointed members of the individual units who will work together to further develop the initiatives implemented by the Travel Plan Coordinator and ensure modal shift for the commercial development is maintained.

9.0 MONITORING

9.1 All residents and staff will be required upon 1st occupation to complete a Travel Questionnaire. The Travel Questionnaire will assist in delivering the key principles of the Travel Plan and how the residents and staff will help achieve a lasting modal shift. A site travel report will be produced by the Travel Plan Co-ordinator annually using information from travel questionnaires from both the residential and commercial developments with monitoring of the travel plan implementation the responsibility of SCC.

- 9.2 The major element of the review will involve the re-issuing of the travel questionnaire to every resident and staff member every 12 months. Analysis of the re-issued travel questionnaires will yield more up to date mode split information to be included within the annual report. Information taken from the travel questionnaires will include the following;
 - Monitor take up of bus pass ticketing incentives
 - Monitoring of Personalised Travel Planning and its outcome
 - Monitor the take up of car share schemes
- 9.3 Monitoring reviews will be undertaken at time periods considered appropriate by SCC. The objective of the review will be to assess the success and to identify the potential for future refinement of the plan.
- 9.4 A Monitoring review will be undertaken by SCC that will incorporate the results of on-going monitoring throughout the preceding period. Any issues can then be discussed with the Travel Plan Coordinator and any refinement of the plan can be undertaken should the need arise.

10.0 IMPLEMENTATION

10.1 Table 5 below provides a summary of the entire package of measures detailed within this report and how they are to be implemented and monitored.

- The implementation of the Travel Plan will be the responsibility of Clowes Developments Ltd and East Staffordshire Borough Council. Updating of all information contained herein this document will fall to Clowes Developments Ltd and East Staffordshire Borough Council, however this will be undertaken by the appointed Travel Plan Coordinator. Monitoring will be undertaken by the travel plan co-ordinator and discussed with SCC.
- 10.3 The Travel Plan must be agreed prior to 1st occupation of the site and the active implementation of the Travel Plan on site will commence from 1st occupation. Various measures relating to the plan will be implemented as agreed in this document.







Further to your email, ideally I would prefer a meeting to discuss the scope of the TA. However I would expect the TA being compiled in accordance with the Dft guidance on Transport Assessments March 2007. In terms of the junctions to be assessed I would expect you include the following:

- site access/s,
- Doveway A518/B5030 roundabout,
- Doveway A518/Derby Road A518 roundabout,
- Town Meadows Way/DovebankA522 Roundabout,
- Mini roundabout on the Derby Road A518 jn Dovefield.

How many accesses are being proposed, from what I understand the proposed housing is to be off Pennycroft Lane? If so then I would expect you to also consider the following junctions;

- Park Street/Cheadle Road High Street Uttoxeter,
- PennyCroft lane/Park Street Uttoxeter include Croft Grove which forms a staggered junction,
- Park Avenue in Ashbourne Road,
- Ashbourne Road in Johnson Road,
- Johnson Road Jn Park Avenue/Park Street

Whilst I accept that for the residential development the above looks a little excessive but following other developments in that area we had a lot of local residents objecting because of the perceived congestion so to avoid any issues I would like these issues to be addressed straight off.

Given the development is close to the trunk road network I would suggest that you liaise with Kevin Harvey at the HA, (0121 678 8505), but I would expect the Ashbourne Road B5030/A50 Roundabout and the Derby Road A518/A50 Roundabout being included as a minimum.

Before I comment on the proposed trip rates I will require the full TRICS print outs so I can view the sites included.

Finally the travel plan I would expect you to provide a travel plan in accordance with the Dft's guidance Good Practice Guidelines: Delivering Travel Plans through the planning process April 2009 and the County Councils guidance which can be found of the internet.

James,

I'll be dealing with this for a few weeks more but there will be a change in personnel very shortly. I'll advise when I know more.

Trip Rates

The supplied site location diagram indicates that the site sits out on the edge of town in what could be considered to be a suburban character area. We note that in some cases, the 'edge of town centre' category has been used. We consider sites that fall into this category are not representative of the application site and therefore 'suburban' and 'edge of town' sites selection should be used.

In all cases, the site selection has been undertaken with too narrow reference to the site size. A wider variation would be acceptable and allow a broader range of sites to be included in the sample.

Some specific points:

<u>Residential</u> - 'Edge of town centre' sites should be avoided as these sites are unlikely to be representative of the application site. The range of number of units selected is too narrow to provide an adequate sample size. We would suggest a range of 35 – 140 units. The regional selections are also too restrictive and should be balanced between the need for a reasonable sample size with the need account for regional differences in trip generation. As a starting point, London and Northern Ireland should be omitted.

<u>B2</u> - For the purposes of trip rate selection the 'Industrial Unit' land use category has been used. This is acceptable if a single unit, however we would recommend you use the Industrial Estate Cass if more than one B2 class building is included as part of the planning application. B8 - The use of the 'edge of town centre' site selection parameter is unacceptable.

Other Points

Insofar as SRN junction assessments are concerned, the two A50 Junctions (A518 and B5030) would be fine for the purposes of this exercise.

Distribution based around Census data would be fine. A gravity model would be acceptable if our colleagues at SCC are content with this approach.

Future year assessment is generally 10 years post application date.

I'd reiterate Geoff's points (his email 1st April) on the travel plan.

I hope you find these comments helpful.
