# Presentation of Work

# Artists Receipt

This Exhibition shows a wide variety of work produced by artists

2D work must not be larger than 400mm (15.75ins) by 400mm including any frame

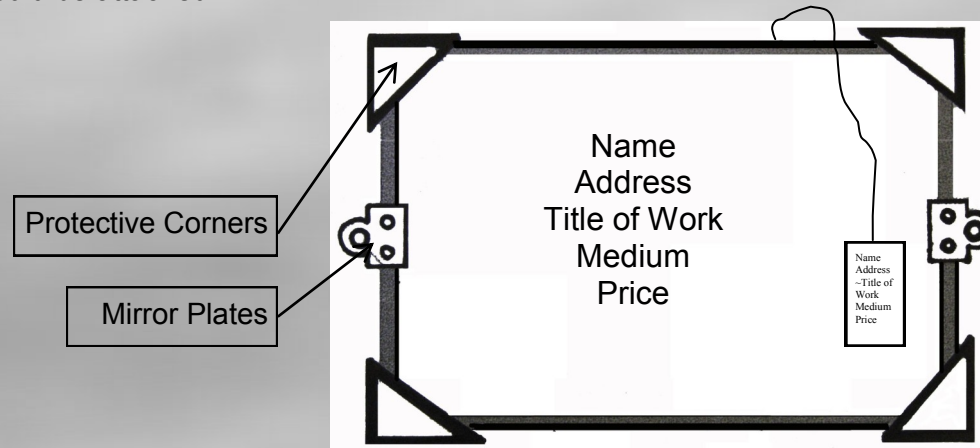
3D work (ceramics, sculpture, craft etc) must fit inside a 400mm cube

It encourages inclusion of textiles, painting, drawing, collage, photography (including digital), ceramics, sculpture, woodcraft, embroidery, knitting, patchwork, etc

The title, date, medium and price of each work together with the artist's name must be shown on a label stuck on the back of the work and also on a tie on label securely attached to the work so that the label hangs visibly over the front of the works. For all 2D work frames should be sturdy and fitted with two mirror plates halfway up each side (see diagram). No other fixing, string, or wires should be attached
