Scrutiny of Queens Hospital takes place at a countywide level, but East Staffs scrutiny group members have been actively attending County meetings representing the East Staffordshire view.

Additionally, the chair and members have been closely liaising with Queens Hospital and Derby Hospital to help understand the consequences and possible opportunities around the collaboration between both hospitals.
