# 1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 For the Council to note and approve changes to the Council's Constitution.

# 2. Background

- 2.1 The Council is required to review its constitution regularly.
- 2.2 This report brings forward the latest proposals for changes.

# 3. <u>Contribution to Corporate Priorities</u>

3.1 This report does not directly contribute to Corporate Priorities but the Council's Constitution is an important document in enabling the Council to implement the Corporate Plan.

# 4. **Proposed Changes to the Constitution**

- 4.1 Part 2 (Articles), paragraph 15.6 delete the requirement for the Monitoring Officer to give Members a printed copy of the Constitution. Include a requirement for the Monitoring Officer to ensure that all Members have access to an electronic copy of the Constitution.
- 4.2 Part 3E (Functions and Procedures of the Audit Committee) insert a new paragraph 1.17 to clarify that part of the Committee's role is to review and approve the Annual

Governance Statement, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the Audit and Accounts Regulations 2015.

- 4.3 Part 4D (Contract Procedure Rules) update the minor alterations shown in tracked changes at the Appendix to this report.
- 4.4 Part 4H (Financial Regulations) minor updates shown in tracked changes, to update references to legislations; and to clarify officer responsibility.
- 4.5 At a meeting of Standards Committee on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2017, Committee Members resolved to recommend that Council adopts changes to Part 5A (Code of Conduct for Councillors) in order to and Part 5G (Social Media Policy for Councillors).
- 4.6 As far as Part 5A is concerned, the recommendation is to extend the scope of the Code to include the Mayor's Consort/Mayoress and the Deputy Mayor's Consort/Deputy Mayoress whenever they accompany the Mayor or deputy Mayor respectively to official engagements. The proposed amendment is shown in tracked changes at paragraph 1.3.2 of Part 5A.
- 4.7 As far as Part 5G is concerned, Standards Committee recommend prohibiting the inclusion of "Councillor" or "Cllr" in the username on any social media account. The proposed amendment is shown in tracked changes at at paragraph 5.2 of Part 5G.

# 5. Re-adoption of Constitution

The Council is recommended to re-adopt the whole Constitution on an annual basis. The new Constitution, with the changes outlined above, is available electronically by following the hyperlink at Appendix 1 of this Report.
