Dear Sir,

You have requested the **dates and times of recorded incidents and visits** for the Middle Bell over the last 6 months, I have been advised by our Legal Department that this constitutes a 'request for information' which required a response by the 28th October 2020. The details of the information you have requested is as follows:

3rd August 2020 16:41 complaint logged about social distancing concerns. The matters were discussed with the premises.

4th August 2020 (No time logged) Complaint received regarding raised voices from customers in the external areas with benches (mainly the area at the rear of the pub) and also noise from car stereos of cars parked in the pub car park. This complaint was closed on the 8th October 2020 noise subsided no nuisance substantiated. This complaint also included reports of ASB off the premises of the pub but believed by the reporter to be being caused by customers who had left the pub, this was reported to the police by the reporter and not followed up by ourselves as it is out of our remit.

15th August 2020 17:20 Email received from the Police to make us aware of reported anti-social behaviour issues.

18th August 2020 15:17 Email received detailing concerns about ASB, noise and social distancing issues.

21st August 2020 21:22 Visit made by 2 Officers from Environmental Health and a Police Officer to check on Covid control measures.

24th August 2020 14:19 Complaint logged about anti-social behaviour, Covid control measures and under aged drinking.

26th August 2020 18:31 Email received from the Police advising us about concerns over a proposed event, the premises was spoken to and the Officer was satisfied with control measures to be implemented.

20th August 2020 01:52 Complaint received about ASB, forwarded to the Police for their enforcement.

10th September 2020 (No time logged) Complaint received about ASB off the premises of the pub but believed by the reporter to be being caused by customers who had left the pub, the reporter was advised that this was not within our remit. The offer forwarded the details to the police and ESBC licensing department, the reporter advised that they had contacted the police and also ESBC licensing regarding the issues.
