13/20 MONITORING OFFICER'S ANNUAL REPORT

The Monitoring Officer informed Members that since the last annual report in February 2019 the Council had received the following member conduct complaint:

Two formal complaints about possible breaches of the Code of Conduct and the Social Media Code by one member of the Borough Council (now an ex-Councillor). The Councillor had declined the Monitoring Officer's offer of an informal resolution and the matter would have been dealt with by formal means;

One formal complaint about possible breaches of the Code of Conduct by a member of one Parish Council with the Borough. In that instance the Monitoring Officer had found that there had been no breach:

Two formal complaints about two members of another Parish Council. The complaints were set within a wider context of underlying problems affecting the operation of the Parish Council. The Monitoring Officer was giving support and advice to the Parish Council Clerk with the aim of addressing the wider issues.
