## Benchmarking Report (Year End Performance 2017/18)

## 1. Introduction

- 1.1. The following report details figures for the financial year 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 for a number of local authorities initially identified using the CIPFA 'Nearest Neighbours' model. The following authorities provided figures for this benchmarking exercise:
  - East Staffordshire Borough Council
  - Gedling Borough Council
  - High Peak Borough Council
  - North Warwickshire Borough Council
  - Erewash Borough Council
  - East Northamptonshire Council
  - South Kesteven District Council
  - Chorley Council
- 1.2. However it should be noted that not all participating authorities are in a position to provide data for all the performance indicators in the exercise. A comparison table for each performance indicator is shown below, where a sufficient number of Councils have provided comparable data for that indicator.
- 1.3. To ensure data quality and allow for fair comparison between the participating authorities, the participating authorities were asked to highlight where any performance indicator was not calculated using previously published NI / BVPI definitions or guidance.
- 1.4. Where no additional comment has been made to highlight variations, then the report assumes that the figures provided are cumulative and that they are calculated in accordance with recognised NI / BVPI definitions. Other comments provided by the relevant participating authority have also been detailed where appropriate.
