Parking Standards Supplementary Planning Document

**Adoption Statement**

This statement is prepared in accordance with The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012.

On 13<sup>th</sup> September 2017 the Council adopted the Parking Standards Supplementary Planning Document.

The Council published its draft Supplementary Planning Document on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2017 and invited representations by 18<sup>th</sup> July 2017. In total 9 representations were received.

The SPD was modified as follows to take account of representations made, pursuant to Section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004:

- Make reference to safe and secure cycle parking
- For development proposals to consider the expected timing of users of shared parking areas
- Define what is considered a major planning application
- Amend parking standards for Class C2 uses, sheltered accommodation proposals, schools and colleges
- Include reference to the setting of Conservation Areas
- Include reference to the requirement for electronic charging points
- Include a reference to the distance from off site parking provision where this cannot be included on site
- Add additional information in relation to Travel Plans

The Council made these modifications to address representations and provide further clarity to the document.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 6 weeks after the date on which revision of the supplementary planning document was adopted.
