## **1 FUNCTIONS OF FULL COUNCIL**

1.1.1	Elect the Mayor (Council Chairman) and the Deputy Mayor (Council Vice
	Chairman) <sup>1</sup>
1.1.2	Appoint and remove the Leader <sup>2</sup>
1.1.3	Approve and amend the Policy Framework <sup>3</sup>
1.1.4	Approve and amend the Budget <sup>4</sup>
1.1.5	Approve a departure from the Policy Framework and/or the Budget where
	the executive decision maker is minded to make their decision in a manner
	which would be contrary to, or not wholly in accordance with, the Policy
	Framework or the Budget <sup>5</sup>
1.1.6	Establish, abolish and decide the terms of reference and the composition of
	Full Council Committees/Panels and make appointments, including co-
	opted members, to them and other non-executive bodies <sup>6</sup>
1.1.7	Appoint Chairmen of Full Council Committees/Panels <sup>7</sup>
